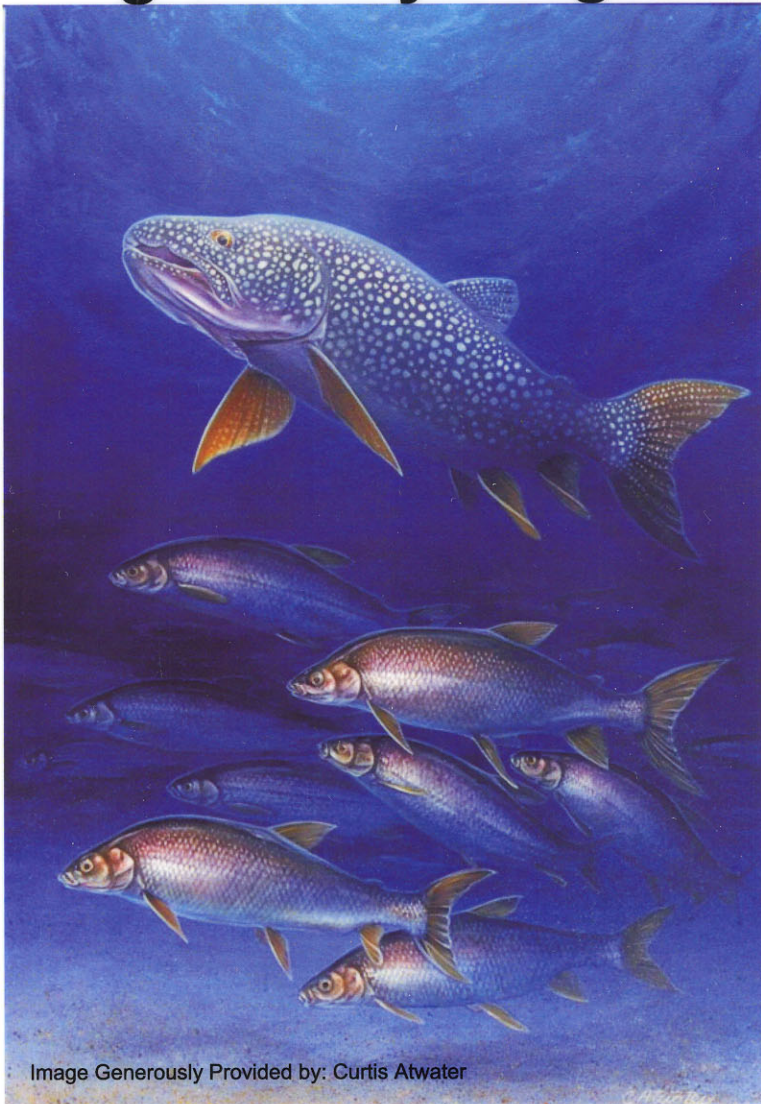


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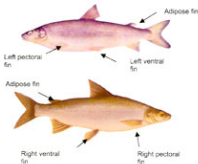
**LAKE SIMCOE FISHERIES STAKEHOLDER COMMITTEE**

Thank you for your cooperation in completing this angler diary. The information you are providing will help us evaluate fisheries management efforts on Lake Simcoe. As an active angler, you can help protect and improve your sport by accurately recording your fishing effort and catches in this book.

Please follow the instructions carefully:

1. Record information about your trip the same day; do not rely on your memory.
2. Record all fishing trips, even if no fish were caught.
3. Record the species and number of each fish caught, harvested and released.
4. For lake trout, whitefish and cisco, please record the total length and fin clip information (ensure adipose is checked)
5. Total length is measured from the tip of the snout to the tip of the tail with the tail fin lobes compressed to give maximum possible length.
6. Record all fin clips observed; carefully examine each lake trout and whitefish for missing or deformed fins which indicate that the fish was stocked. If no clip is observed, please record NC. See illustration below for fin clip names.
